PASSENGER INFORMATION - DUBLIN

DUBLIN AIRPORT: <http://www.dublinairport.com/> is located about 10 km north of Dublin city centre, near the M50 and M1 motorways.

Isle of Man services are provided by Aer Arann www.aerarann.com

Public transport at Dublin airport:

- **Dublin Bus** <http://www.dublinbus.ie/> +353 (0) 1 873 4222 operates throughout Dublin, including Airlink [747](#) every 10 minutes to BusAras (Central Bus Station) via O'Connell Street and [748](#) every 30 minutes to Heuston Station via BusAras.
- **Aircoach** <http://www.aircoach.ie/> +353 (0) 1 844 7118 offers services from Dublin Airport to the City Centre, South Dublin and Greystones, as well as to Belfast via Newry. The City Centre service stops at most of the major hotels around Dublin City and their Greystones service stops at key locations in the Dublin South / North Wicklow area.
- **BusEirann** <http://www.buseireann.ie/bubble.php?id=164> – run coach services to destinations all over Ireland, many direct from Dublin Airport
- **Flybus** <http://www.flybus.ie> +353 (0) 1 8243030. serve Liffey Valley Shopping Centre – The Mill Shopping Centre, Clondalkin – The Square, Tallaght.
- **Urbus** <http://www.urbus.ie/> +353 (0) 1 8243030 serve Castleknock, Blanchardstown and Swords.

DUBLIN FERRYPORT is on the north bank of the River Liffey, about 2 miles east from the centre of Dublin. IOM services use Terminal 1 (Irish Ferries). The Dublin Port Tunnel links up to the M50 and the West Link Bridge. The East link bridge provides quick access to and from South Dublin. Tolls are payable on the Tunnel and Link Bridge crossings. Dublin Ferryport is reached by the M1 from the North, the N11 from the South and the N7 from the West. Refreshments, an ATM machine and internet access are available at the passenger terminal.

Seasonal IOM services are operated by the **IOM Steam Packet Company** www.steam-packet.com

There is very limited public transport at Dublin Ferryport:

- **Dublin Bus** <http://www.dublinbus.ie/> +353 (0) 1 873 4222 operate three or four services each day between Dublin Ferryport and BusAras (Central Bus Station) at times around the arrival and departure of Irish Ferries vessels.
- **Connecting buses to/from for Steam Packet sailings**, organised by the IOMSPC local agent, are usually available to the City Centre but details are not available in advance
- **Taxis** need to be pre-booked to meet incoming passengers at Dublin Ferryport. Dublin taxi companies include [Network Taxis](#) +353 (0) 1 295 7777, [Trinity Taxis](#) +353 (0) 1 708 2222. [City Cabs](#): 018 72 72 72 and [Cab 2000](#): 018 900 900 (phone numbers only operate from within Eire).
