- **Supporters meetings** were held on 23rd June at the NSC. These meetings continue to be an important opportunity for briefing supporters on developments and for listening to supporters current concerns.
 - **Meetings** were held with the Director of Harbours, the Head of Buses and the Chief Executive of Flight Support during the period April - June.  - TravelWatch issued statements around the time of the collapse of **Euromanx** and continue to monitor the fall out from this incident.
