Passenger Information – Birmingham

Birmingham airport www.bhx.co.uk

- is located 8 miles (13km) east of Birmingham, on the A45 Coventry Road, one mile west of M42 Junction 6.
- Terminals 1 and 2 are adjacent and interconnected. The Air-Rail Link, bus stops, taxi rank, car parks and other landside facilities are convenient for both terminals.

IOM flights use Terminal 2 and are operated by

Public transport at Birmingham Airport:

- **Trains** – The free frequent Air-Rail Link shuttle connects to Birmingham International Station (500m) and is open 0515 to 0200. There are frequent rail services to Birmingham New Street (journey approx 15 mins) and twice an hour by **Virgin Trains** London Euston (85 mins) – via Coventry and Rugby.
- Bus Link service 966 operate every 30 minutes from the airport bus stop L to Solihull station in 25 mins for **Chiltern Railways** to Warwick, High Wycombe and London Marylebone
- Bus Link Services 717,757,767 and 777 provide a 15 minutes frequency connection from bus stop M to Coleshill Parkway station in 16 mins for **London Midland** to Leicester, Peterborough & Cambridge

- **Local Buses** – Services include route 900 (also 58) operating every 20/30 minutes to Birmingham City Centre (Moor Street Interchange) in 40/45 minutes. Local bus and rail times and fares are available from www.networkwestmidlands.com or telephone 0871 200 2233
