## Public transport at Birmingham Airport:

- The free frequent **Air-Rail Link shuttle** connects the airport with **Birmingham International Station** (500m) and runs 05.00 to 02.00. There are frequent rail services to Birmingham New Street (journey approx 10 mins) and three times an hour by **Virgin Trains** to London Euston (min 68 mins) – via Coventry and Rugby. There are hourly direct services with **Cross Country** trains to Manchester, Bournemouth (via Reading and Southampton), as well as some direct services to Holyhead, and Scotland but more via Birmingham New Street

- 900 operating to Birmingham City Centre (Pavillions) in 30/45 minutes from stop J and to Coventry (stop K).
- 966 to Solihull (stop K) for **Chiltern Railways** to Warwick, High Wycombe and London Marylebone
- 966 to Erdington and 777 to Atherstone (stop L). Service 777 provides a 30 minute frequency connection to Coleshill Parkway station in approx 15 mins for **London Midland** trains to Leicester, Peterborough & Cambridge

*NB services 900/966 are operated by National Express West Midlands and service 777 by Central Buses. This should not be confused with National Express 777 to Luton and Stansted.*
