

DUBLIN AIRPORT: <https://www.dublinairport.com/>

Location: about 10 km north of Dublin city centre, near the M50 and M1 motorways.

- **IOM services** operate from **Terminal 2** and are provided by **Aer Lingus Regional**. Through booking from IOM with **Aer Lingus** www.aerlingus.com to USA/Canada avoids UK Air Passenger Duty.

Public transport at Dublin airport:

- **Airlink 747** runs every 15 minutes to Heuston Railway Station via Busáras provincial bus station and O'Connell Street - see <http://dublinbus.ie/en/Your-Journey1/Timetables/All-Timetables/7471/>

DUBLIN FERRYPORT :

Location - on the north bank of the River Liffey, about 2 miles east from the centre of Dublin.

- **IOM services** (Seasonal & Xmas) are operated by the **IOM Steam Packet Company** www.steam-packet.com and use **Terminal 1** (Irish Ferries). Refreshments and internet access are available at the passenger terminal.

Public transport at Dublin Ferryport – Terminal 1:

- **Dublin Bus** <http://www.dublinbus.ie/> +353 (0) 1 873 4222 operate hourly services (Route 53) between Talbot Street (3 mins walk from Connolly Railway Station, Busáras provincial bus station and LUAS Trams) and Dublin Ferryport. Journey time is approx 23 mins. Fares must be paid in coins, with SmartCards or pre-paid tickets.
