Passenger Information – Liverpool

Liverpool John Lennon Airport: www.liverpoolairport.com

The single-terminal airport is situated south of the city centre and is signposted from the A561. IOM flights are operated by **Flybe** www.flybe.com (Reservations 0871 700 2000) and **easyJet** www.easyjet.com

- The 500 bus service provides a direct and frequent service to a number of stops in Liverpool City Centre – including Lime St Station (the stop is in Skelhorne Street at the side of the station).
- Terravision Coaches operate an hourly service A40 to/from Manchester (Sackville Street).

- Liverpool South Parkway Station (LSP) is linked to the airport terminal by frequent buses (services 501 and 86A - journey time around 10 mins) and is served by trains to Liverpool Lime Street, Warrington Central, Crewe, Stafford and Birmingham New Street, Manchester, Stockport, Sheffield, Nottingham, Peterborough and Norwich. At Crewe and Stafford there are connections to London Euston. At Warrington there are connections to Leeds and York.,
- Merseyrail Electrics trains serve Liverpool South Parkway with direct services to the City Centre / Southport every 15 minutes. Passengers can change at Liverpool Central for Chester, the Wirral and Ormskirk.

Ferry Terminal:

Ferry services are operated by the **Isle of Man Steam Packet Company** www.steam-packet.com Recorded sailing update information is available on 01624 645 745. Passengers are advised to provide a contact number when booking so they can be advised of any sailing alterations.

Foot Passengers check-in at the terminal on the Landing Stage - access is via a walkway on the bridge from the vehicle marshalling area

- Citylink C2 buses operate a circular route serving Liverpool Lime Street station (the stop is now on Lime Street in front of the station), Queen Square Bus Station), Princes Parade (IOM terminal) and Canada Boulevard (Mersey Ferries). This service operates in both directions along Princes Parade so passengers should board the bus to Lime Street at the stop on the river side of Princes Parade.
- The nearest Merseyrail station is James Street on the Wirral Line – this is about 10 minutes walk from the ferry terminal.
- Mersey Ferries operate from Pier Head to Seacombe and Birkenhead Woodside hourly through the day.

*Services between Nov and late March operated by the **Ben-my-Chree** use the (Norfolkline) Birkenhead 12 Quays terminal.*

- When there are sailings, coach transfers to Birkenhead for departing passengers usually leave the Liverpool Landing Stage at 12.30. For passengers arriving at Birkenhead a transfer to Liverpool Landing Stage and Lime Street Station is provided leaving at approx 13.00. Transit time is around 30 minutes. Timings and service are subject to change so check at the time of booking.
- There is no public transport serving the Twelve Quays terminal which is being used for Steam Packet winter sailings. The nearest Merseyrail station is Birkenhead Hamilton Square. Local buses run from Woodside, near Hamilton Square Station and the Woodside Mersey Ferries stage.
